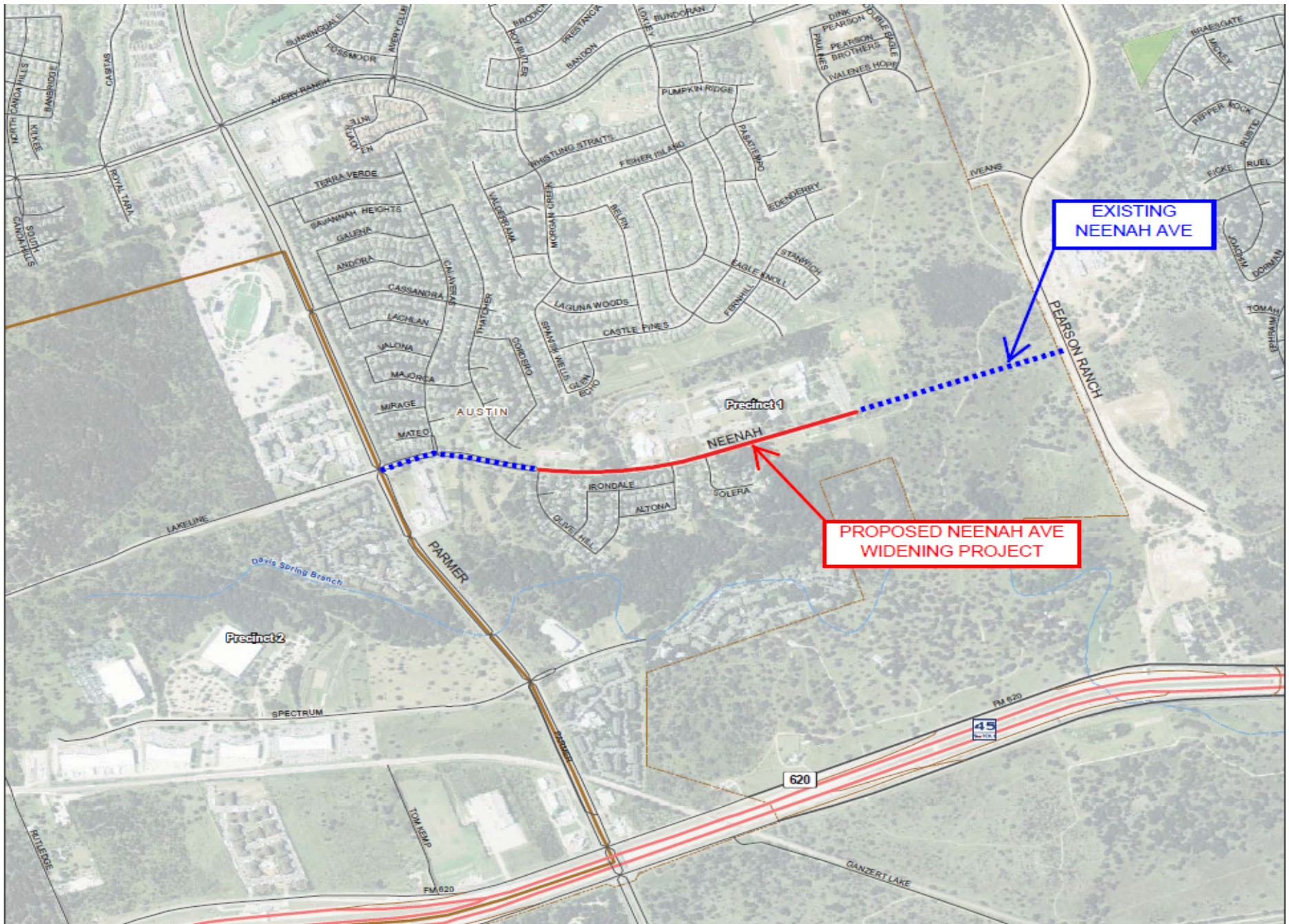

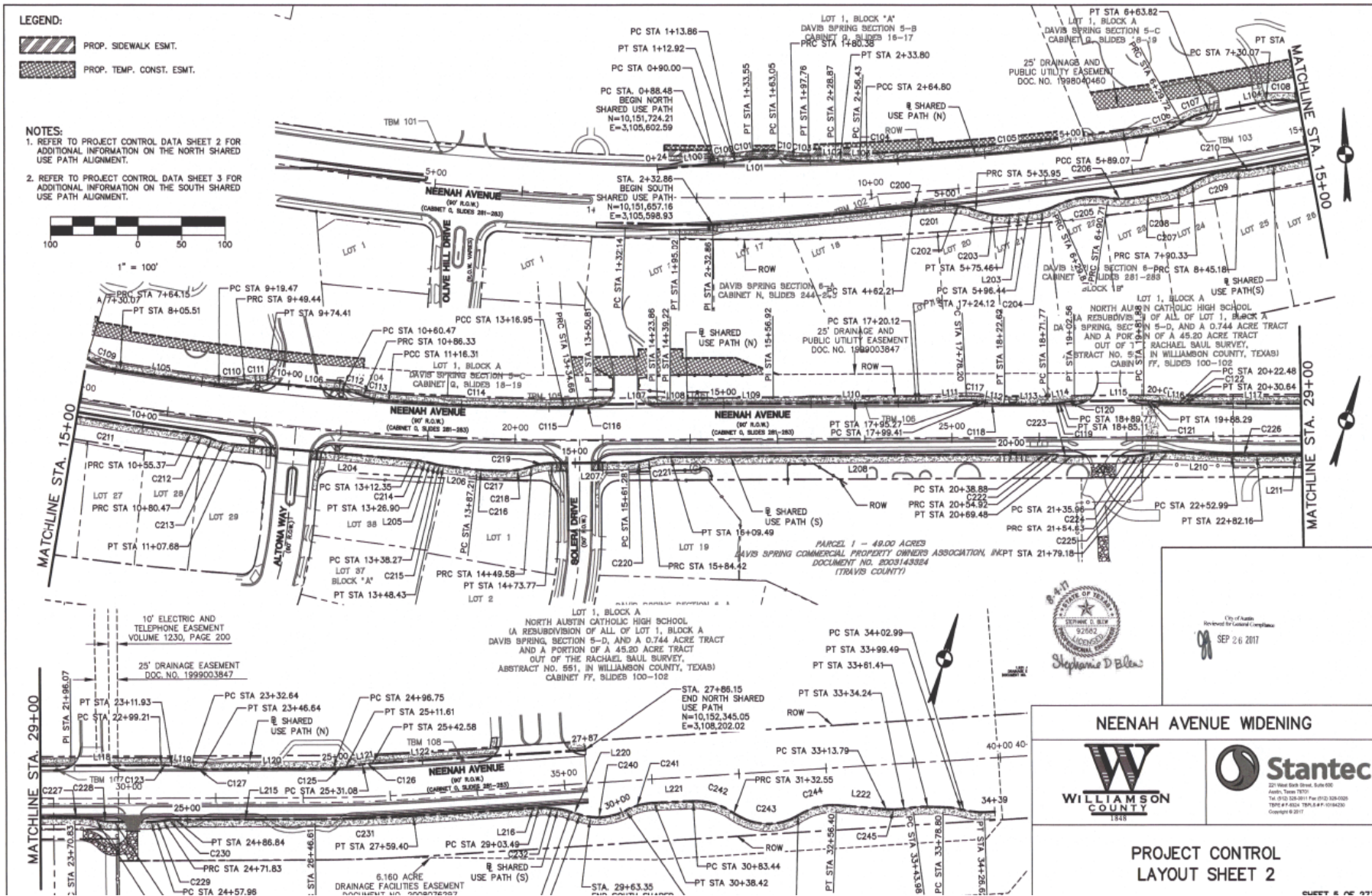
Project Information

- ❑ Project will widen Neenah Ave. from two lanes to four lanes with continuous left turn lane from Olive Hill to St. Dominic Savio Catholic High School
- ❑ Project will add 8-ft shared use path on both sides of Neenah Ave
- ❑ Project is in City of Austin Owned and Maintained Right of Way
- ❑ Existing speed limit is 30 mph – existing signs to remain

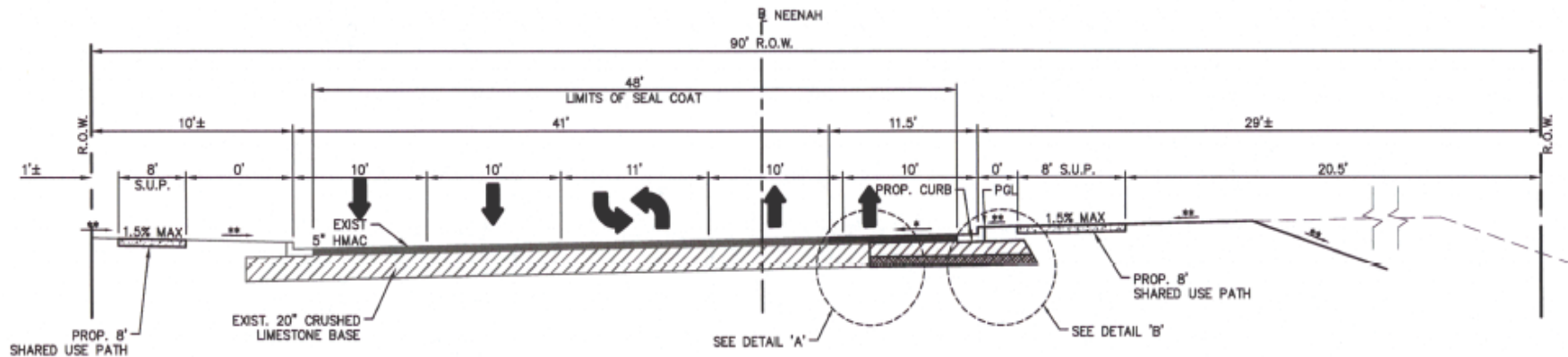
Project Limits



Plan Layout

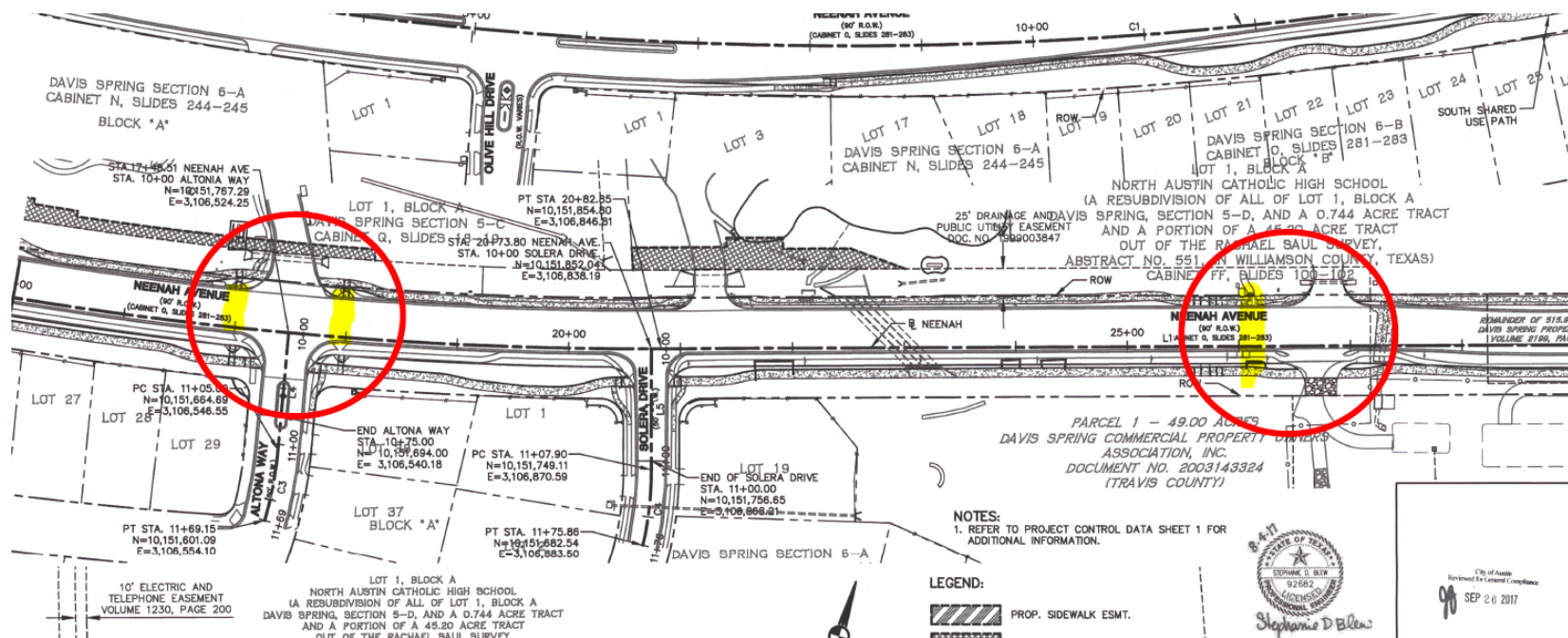


Existing Section

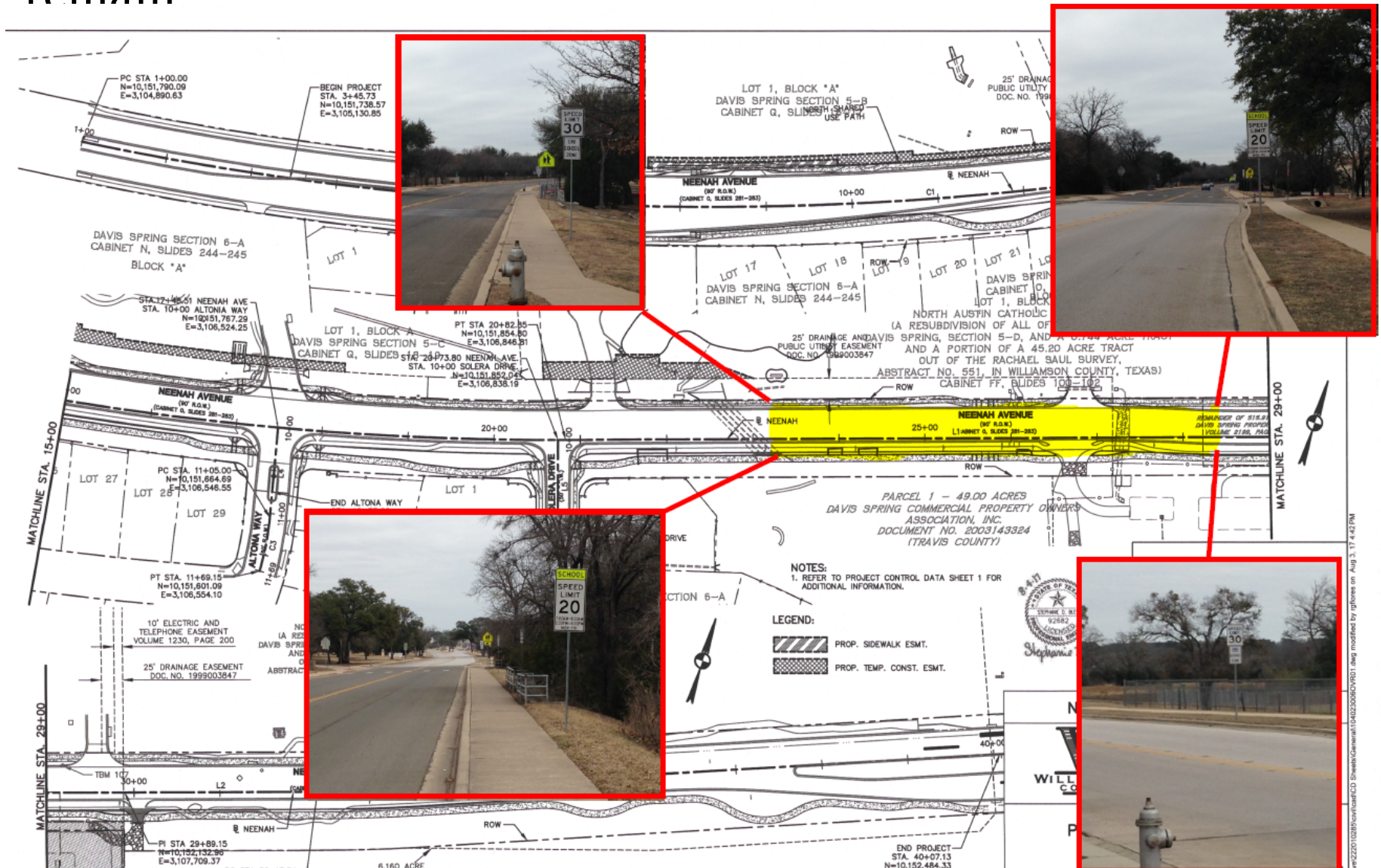


Crosswalks

Construction

- ❑ Construction Contract awarded to Smith Contracting with a low bid of \$2,529,398.54
- ❑ Construction to start in February 2018
- ❑ Construction duration is approximately 12 months
- ❑ Maintain two lanes of traffic during peak hours :
Monday-Friday (6am – 9am and 4pm to 6pm)

After Construction

After the County Project:

- ❑ City of Austin will install new trees to mitigate for trees impacted by the project
- ❑ City of Austin will restripe Neenah Ave from Parmer to Olive Hill after this project is complete
